Lake Shore Resort Rules for The safe use of Carts

Golf Carts' are allowed for a means of transportation within the park. Please use caution while operating or riding on a golf cart. Golf carts can cause injury and even death, *Drive Safely*

- Safety First!
- Driver must be at least 16 years of age to operate a golf cart in Lake Shore Resort Park.
- A 14 through 16 year old may drive a golf cart, however, a parent must accompany that driver and be in the front seat of the golf cart at all times.
- ALL riders MUST be seated, No more passengers than seating safely allows, no sitting in other peoples laps (other than infant children). ABSOLUTELY NO STANDING ON GOLF CARTS!
- Golf carts are required to follow all posted 15MPH speed limits signs, drivers are expected to drive in a responsible way.
- Golf Carts are required to drive on the roads only. DO NOT cut across other owners campsites or grass areas.
- Pedestrians always have the right of way.
- Golf Carts <u>must</u> have mounted headlights and taillights to operate after dark. Flash lights are NOT permitted to be used as headlights or taillights.
- Property Owners with golf carts are required to maintain insurance on the cart in order to operate the cart on any roads in Lake Shore Resort.
- Golf Carts are to be maintained, we reserve the right to check golf carts for safety. i.e. brakes, lights, noise. Some carts may be placed on limited operating times.
- Please secure your golf cart when not in use. Do not allow children to play on a golf cart for their safety and that of surrounding guests and property.
- Each owner's section and lot number must be visibly displayed on the front and back or left and right sides of their golf cart, using a minimum of three 3" numbers.
- ATV's, RTV's, dirt bikes, 4 wheelers, side by sides or similar means of transportation are NOT permitted to be driven on the roads in Lake Shore Resort Park.
- Intoxicated or impaired golf cart drivers are not allowed to operate any vehicle, including golf carts, on the roads of Lake Shore Resort.
- Property owners that have Golf cart accidents resulting in bodily injury and/or property damage are immediately suspended from the use of golf carts on Lake Shore Resort roads until reviewed and reinstated by the Board of Directors.

MOPEDS (MDC-motor driven cycle) are permitted to be driven in the park if the following requirements are met:

(MDC) Class A

Class A MDC complies with IC 9-19 and 49 CFR 571

- Financial responsibility (insurance) required.
- Indiana BMV registration with a MDC Class A plate.
- A written test and a modified motorcycle operation test are required to obtain this endorsement.
- Any valid driver's license with an M/C endorsement or MC endorsement with a restriction to MDC Class A or M/C Learners€™s Permit is required.
- Operator under 18 years of age must wear eye protection and DOT approved helmet.
- Headlamp must be illuminated while in operation.
- Must have headlamp, tail lamp, rear reflector and brake lamp.
- Driven on the far right of the roadway, except to turn left or pass.
- May not be driven on an Interstate Highway or sidewalk.
- In addition to the operator, one other passenger is permitted to be carried on the seat or saddle

(MDC) Class B

- Class B MDC not exceeding fifty (50) cubic centimeters.
- No insurance required.
- Indiana BMV registration with a MDC Class B plate.
- A modest written BMV test is required covering traffic control devices, such as signage.
- Must have either a valid Indiana ID Card with a Class B MDC Endorsement OR a valid driver's license (does not include a learners permit).
- May not be operated by a person less than 15 years of age.
- Operator under 18 years of age, must wear eye protection and DOT approved helmet.
- Headlamp must be illuminated while in operation.
- Must have headlamp, tail lamp, rear reflector and brake lamp.
- Driven on the far right of the roadway, except to turn left or pass.
- May not be driven on an Interstate Highway or sidewalk.
- May not be operated in excess of 35 miles per hour, even if the posted speed limit is greater.
- NO passengers may be carried on a Class B MDC.

Golf Cart Penalties:

Offense of underage, reckless driving or previous verbal warning from LSR Security and/or Board of Director will result in a \$100.00 fine. This fine must be paid prior to the golf cart operating in the park again.

Additional Violations

Any additional violations will result in the loss of all privilege to operate a golf cart in the park. The golf cart must immediately be placed on the owners' property. Length of loss of golf cart driving privileges will be a minimum of 60 days and may be extended by the LSR Board of Directors.
